Dear Parents and Friends,

Having said that, I am grateful for the wonderful teachers we have at CBA. As you know, all schools in Ontario are closed, however, learning is still continuing at CBA!. The teachers have all moved their **classrooms to virtual platforms**. Teachers are posting work related to your child's Bible, language, math, social studies/science curriculum units. The JK/SK children will also receive packages of work to complete.

Some intermediate classes will be participating in a **virtual classroom** with live interaction with Mr. McCleary while the younger students will be able to hear Mrs. Willett telling a Bible story and giving a morning message each day.

Your teachers will be **communicating with each of their students starting tomorrow** on their classroom platforms (e.g. Google classroom) and posting work for them to do.. We suggest that 45 minutes is a suitable time of engagement for young children to work on their tasks while older students can work for up to 2 hours on their daily lessons.

All of the research recommends that the best time to **work is in the morning** and at the same time each day, (e.g. 9:30 - on) for best results. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher by email for assistance. They are available during the regular school hours.

In order to continue the curriculum units, several workbooks and activities need to be with the students in their homes. We have arranged a **car pick-up for Wednesday morning** between 8:00 AM and 12:00 noon at the **front of the school**.

We are asking everyone to **post their last name on a sheet of paper on the passenger window** of their vehicle. When you pull up to the front doors of the school, please open your trunk or front passenger window and a bag of your child's materials will be placed in your vehicle. All passengers are to remain in the vehicle. No one is allowed to enter the school building.

Finally, we wish everyone an enjoyable time with their family. We pray you will feel God's peace and joy while working together. And students, remember to keep making good choices and shining for Jesus at all times.
