Fee Schedule for 2020-2021

- 1) Application & Administration Fees (for those new to CBA) one time, non-refundable:
 \$100.00 per family

- 2) Registration Fees (non-refundable) per year:
 \$150.00 per student

- 3) Tuition: **Junior Kindergarten** from September 2019 to June 2020
 5 mornings or 5 full days **\$367** per month for twelve months (\$4,400 for the year)

- Senior Kindergarten to Grade 8** from September 2019 to June 2020
 1 child **\$553** per month for twelve months (\$6,630 for the year)
 2 children **\$775** per month for twelve months (\$9,300 for the year)
 3+ children **\$913** per month for twelve months (\$10,950 for the year)

Please note:

- The **\$100.00** application fee is for the initial application to attend CBA and not a yearly charge. **This is not refundable.**
- The **\$150.00** student **registration fee** ensures a spot for your child/children for September.
- Registration fees for **new students** to CBA are payable upon their acceptance.
- Tuition Fees are per month. There are two options:
 - 1) Monthly post-dated cheques from July 1, 2020 to June 1, 2021 or
 - 2) Pre-authorized payments from July 1, 2020 to June 2021 (see above for rates).
- Tuition Fees are due on the **first day** of each month.
- **Pre-authorized payment or post-dated cheques** are the preferred method of payment.
- If a cheque is returned N.S.F., a fee of \$30.00 will be added to the account.
- Once a student has been accepted at CBA, any removal of the child, **on or after the first day of the month in which he/she is withdrawn, requires parents to pay the tuition fee for the remainder of the month and the following month upon *written* notice of withdrawal.** For example, to withdraw on September 7, 2020 is to forfeit the September & October tuition fee.
- Tuition fees do not include uniforms, end of year field trips, extra-curricular competitions, or other optional activities such as private music lessons, or ESL classes.

Tuition Assistance Programme

A limited amount of money is available for a student assistance programme for parents who may require some financial assistance. If you are interested in applying, please contact the CBA office and you will be sent the application forms. Contributions to this fund are always appreciated and very helpful in making possible Christian Education for some parents who would otherwise find it too costly.
