



Curriculum

The Bible forms the foundation upon which all curricula are judged. Central Baptist Academy will remain current and informed with respect to Ontario Ministry of Education and Training guidelines and will seek to appropriately use that which is best for the overall curriculum at the Academy. The Canadian Achievement Test (CAT-4) will be given systematically to Academy students to evaluate their standing in core knowledge and skill areas. This will be a diagnostic tool for both the individual students and the curriculum at-large. The results will be maintained in students' individual Ontario Student Records (OSRs). If you would like to access information in your child's OSR, please make an appointment with the principal.

All textbooks and materials will be selected based on their suitability to achieve the school's educational goals. Basic academic and life skills and the building of Christian character will be emphasized in all subjects. A textbook is not the curriculum; it is only a resource. Therefore, students may not cover all topics or complete all assignments in a book assigned to them for the year.

A systematic study of the Bible is obviously an integral part of the curriculum at Central Baptist Academy. Chapels, at which parents are always welcomed, are conducted weekly.
